- Promote procurement to enhance environmental sustainability by selecting vendors who can offer options to reduce pollution and waste in business operations, such as sourcing transportation that uses alternative energy.

- Support and promote the procurement of goods and services within the country where the business is located to encourage local employment, develop skills, and provide careers for the surrounding community, reducing travel and transportation burdens.
- Support and promote sustainable procurement, considering environmental, social, and corporate governance (ESG) throughout the supply chain.
- Support and promote ethical procurement under relevant laws, regulations, standards, and rules, conducting business based on correctness, transparency, honesty, and integrity, avoiding conflicts of interest, respecting intellectual property, protecting confidential company information, and combating corruption.
- Support and promote environmentally responsible procurement, recognizing the importance of the environment for both the local community and the global environment, managing resources efficiently, controlling, managing, and disposing of waste, hazardous waste, and pollution properly and appropriately to minimize environmental impact.
